Reminders:

Dress Code – If a student wears leggings, they may not have see through panels in them and the shirt worn with them must be fingertip in length.

Food & Drink – All Food & Drink, other than water must be consumed in the cafeteria and disposed of afterward. Students are not allowed in the hallway or in class with soda, mocha, coffee, juice, etc....

Dismissal – Students may only be picked up along the school curbside of the street. Students are not allowed to be picked up at the church, convenient store, or opposite curb from the school. If students wait at the rock, please pull forward and have students walk up to you. This will allow parents going through the pick up line to pass safely. Parents may not park on the street between the school and the football field. This is a safety issue for students, our buses, and parents.

Drop Off & Pick Up Reminders

Please help us make morning and afternoon drop off and pick up run smoothly. In the morning, we ask that you pull all the way up to the Unicorn sign on the front post to unload students. This will allow multiple cars to unload at one time. Please do not stop at the first walkway by the bike rack if there are no other cars in front of you. Students should be ready to unload when the vehicle stops so that the line will continue to flow. In the afternoon, we ask that you pull all the way up to the car in front of you and have students walk up to you.

This will allow multiple cars to load at one time and keep the line moving. Please be respectful of others by maintaining your position in line and not jumping in front to pick up your child. Following these simple procedures will make dropping off and picking up run smooth and keep students safe. We thank you for your cooperation.
